Elementary Grades K-5

Kindergarten- All About Me

The All About Me domain introduces students to the human body and senses. Instruction and activities also support the development of emergent literacy skills such as phonological awareness, gross and fine motor movement, and print knowledge.

1st Grade - Weather Wonders

Students build their literacy and science skills as they engage in a study of the weather.

2nd Grade - What's Up in the Sky: A Study of the Sun, Moon, and Stars

Students build their literacy and science skills as they engage in a study of the sun, moon, and stars.

3rd Grade - Water Around the World

This module focuses on the importance of clean freshwater around the world. Students explore our access to water, demands on water, and water pollution.

4th Grade - Animal Defense Mechanisms

Students explore animal defense mechanisms. They build proficiency in writing an informative piece, examining the defense mechanisms of one specific animal about which they build expertise.

5th Grade - The Impact of Natural Disasters

Students read literacy and informational texts to understand the impact of natural disaster on places and people.



Middle School Grades 6-8

Blast off into an unforgettable summer of discovery! Students entering grades 6-8 will dive into action-packed morning sessions where they'll unlock the secrets of English, crack the code of Mathematics, become hands-on scientists, and chart their course to future success through our College/Career Pathways. Specials and Afternoon Classes

Grades K-5 will engage in specials classes such as Physical Education, Music, Art and Exploring Our World.

Grades 6-8 will engage in Afternoon Classes that may include Creative Writing, Art Experience, Health, Digital Photography, International Language, and Sports.
